

2025 Legislative Priorities



HOUSE BILL 1052

Modifies the conduct that constitutes a Hate Crime offense to include when a person commits a specified act in whole or in part because of the perception of another person's characteristics.

HOUSE BILL 1186

Authorizes hospitals and health care entities to dispense or distribute HIV medications in additional circumstances.

HOUSE BILL 1217

Improves housing stability for tenants by limiting the rent and fee increases requiring notice of increases, limiting deposits, authorizing tenant lease termination, and creating lease type parity.

HOUSE BILL 1296

Makes changes to the policies and procedures of school districts, charter schools, and state-tribal education compact schools to ensure a safe and supportive education system for all students.

SENATE BILL 5179

Establishes a process for the investigation of complaints against schools for alleges willful noncompliance with state laws regarding civil rights, harassment, intimidation, and bullying.

SENATE BILL 5490

Requires jail administrators to implement policies and procedures for conducting searches on transgender or intersex people confined at the jail that are compliance with federal law.

SENATE BILL 5557

Requires hospitals to provide treatment to a pregnant person who comes to the hospital with an emergency medical condition that is consistent with applicable standard of care.

SENATE BILL 5577

Requires Medicaid coverage for all FDA-approved HIV antiviral drugs without prior authorization or step therapy.
