- Director Keating testified (OTHER) on benefits of gender inclusive school policies and shared education on outcomes for LGBTQ youth with inclusive education policies for HB 1296.
- LGBTQ Commission provided written testimony (OTHER) for HB 1971.
- Director Keating has regular meetings with our legislative advisors to stay up to date on legislation.
- Commission staff attended weekly group meetings with Representative Mena to discuss legislation.
- Sam and Lisa have bi-weekly meetings with our policy advisor for the governor's office.
- During these meetings we discuss legislation, what constituents are telling us and any other information the governor's team needs to be aware of.
